Although the winter months are dark, Maastricht continues to shine bright. These Magical Light Route will take you to the most beautiful (and illuminated!) spots in the city. Pull on a warm sweater, choose a quiet moment, and take in the magic. Discover these three routes and be amazed by the many historical, cultural, and culinary treasures that the city has to offer during Magical Maastricht.

The Wyck walk

During this route you'll experience Wyck, the trendy city district with its distinctive historical character. Wyck is situated proudly on the banks of the Meuse river, home to many local craftsmen, vintage shops, and delicatessens. Stroll towards Céramique and discover an imposing mixture of modern architecture, inviting museums, and sleek lines that embrace Maastricht's history.

Romantic route

On this route you'll discover the Mestreechter Geis, the real spirit of Maastricht. Romantic and quaint cobbled streets will take you past the chicest of boutiques, the finest terraces and parks, and, of course, Onze Lieve Vrouwebasiliek (Basilica of our Lady), and Vrijthof square.

Stroll around the Sphinxkwartier

The Stroll around the Sphinxkwartier will take you on a journey to discover old and new Maastricht. Here, former factories have been given a new lease of life; be wowed by the combination of modern architecture and original features. The Sphinxkwartier is an industrial district with a proud historic harbour in its centre.
