INFORMATION BUSINESSES

Shops, restaurants, pubs, cafes, hotels and restaurants in Maastricht should expect large numbers of visitors in the city centre on King's Day. However, businesses within the cordons surrounding the royal route will need to think ahead. For example, re-stocking should take place no later than Tuesday morning 26 April. Both visitors and staff will have to park the car further away or come by bicycle/on foot.

What will be the opening hours during King's Day in Maastricht?

Regular opening hours apply on King's Day.

I want to make my business available to journalists or spectators. Is that allowed?

Yes, that's allowed. Please note that you will be responsible for your own and your guests' safety. Don't let too many people stand in front of a window or on a balcony to watch the festivities.

Can I set up a terrace/my terrace?

This is not allowed if you do not have a valid terrace permit. If you have a valid permit, you might still not be able to set up your terrace during King's Day. If this is the case, we will contact you in time. pm. Cars can remain parked but may not enter or exit.
